

The City of Del Rey Oaks will be receiving \$395,672 total in ARPA funding. They have received \$197,836 to date. In December 2021, the Council directed staff to focus on delivering projects that address long-delayed Infrastructure Maintenance and Improvements; and 2) Modernization of Operations.

On February 22, 2022 the Council approved the first group of “low hanging fruit” projects. Those include agenda management software, records management software, and Council Chamber technology upgrades (with an emphasis to facilitate hybrid meetings).

During the pandemic, it became clear how valuable and important our parks are to community health. With this in mind, we will be recommending capital projects that include improvements to our park infrastructure.

It should be noted that the City’s revenue impacts from the pandemic are estimated to be in excess of \$1 million. The City is using the ARPA funding under the Revenue Recovery guidelines.
