

## **Marina American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Plan**

Marina was allocated approximately \$5.4 million of ARPA funds.

At the onset of the pandemic, Marina developed a small business loan program to support local businesses. ARPA funds have since been used to forgive approximately \$190,000 of those business loans.

Marina paid a total of approximately \$85,000 in Premium Pay to City of Marina staff who worked and provided essential services during the height of the pandemic.

The City Council is considering allocating a significant portion of the remaining \$5.2 million in ARPA funds towards city-wide street improvements including both residential neighborhoods and commercial districts. The City has a backlog of \$13 million in street repairs and ARPA funds combined with other revenue sources can provide a kickstart to these critical infrastructure improvements.
